Claude Cattelain (1972, Belgium) lives in Brussels.

Cattelain has shown his work in solo exhibitions at Musée des beaux-arts d'Arras and Calais, at Clovis XV, at MAAC. He took part to the exhibition Soulèvements curated by Georges Didi-Huberman at Jeu de Paume, at MUNTREF and at Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya. Simon Deppierraz (1984, Switzerland) lives in Lausanne.

Mara Fortunatovic (1987, France) lives in Paris.

Planes of stainless steel, wood, or plexiglass, at times painted whiteseeming to disappear into the exhibition space. Takahiro Kudo (1984, Japan) lives in Berlin.

His works range from paintings and sculptures to installations and film. Raised in a middleclass family in Japan, within a railed and twistedly westernized society, Kudo considers himself as a standardized Japanese figure, and consciously revisits this notion of the normalization as a part of primal restrictions he has been engaging in his work.

Emmanuelle Leblanc (1977, France) lives in Bordeaux.

Emmanuelle Leblanc's work has been exhibited in various galleries and institutions in France and abroad: Xenon Bordeaux gallery, kh15 Berlin gallery, Museo San Prisco, Keitelman Brussels gallery, Kalakriti Gallery Hyderabad, Wilford X Temse and Vitrine 65 Paris.. Selected for the International Painting Prize of Vitry-sur-Seine, her works are also part of several private collections in Europe. The artistis also co-founder of Pleonasm, a European platform for the dissemination and promotion of contemporary artists... She is curator of various exhibitions within this structure.

Roman Moriceau (1976, France) lives in Paris.
